# Non-acoustic indicators associated with noise nuisance generated by air traffic around airports in urban areas


### Summary

What are the possible covariance relationships between such variables to confirm the hypotheses of relationships between the set of variables and latent factors? What is the intensity and direction of the presumed cause-and-effect relationships of a given stochastic model?
